Mayor Varnadore called the Baxley City Council to order on this the 3rd day of January 2019, at 6:00 p.m., the purpose of this meeting is to hear public comments on a petition filed by J. E. Holland Properties, requesting the property located on Beach Road, be rezoned from the current Single Family Residential (R-12) Zone to a Multi-Family Residential (RM-10) Zone in voting district 6.
