

Ham Lake Lanes' 2019 Martin Luther King Day Youth No-Tap Bowling Tournament

Payout Ratio: 1:5

Prizes: SMART scholarship money

Number of Games To Be Bowled: Three

Average Used: Highest final average from 2017-18 (minimum 15 games). Bowlers with no qualifying 2017-18 average may use their current average as of 1-21-19 (minimum 15 games). All others must bowl scratch (220).

HDCP: 90% of 220; No limit.

Divisions: If there are less than 24 entries, there will be a single division (A). If there are 24 – 39 entries, two divisions will be formed (A & B). If there are 40 – 59 entries, three divisions will be formed (A – C). If there are 60 – 79 entries, four divisions will be formed (A – D). If there are 80 - 99 entries, five divisions will be formed (A – E). If there are 100 or more entries, then six divisions will be formed (A – F). The division a bowler will compete in will not be determined until both shifts have been completed and results have been tallied. Division A will be comprised of the bowlers with the highest tournament average. Division B will be comprised of the bowlers with the next highest set of tournament averages, and so on. If there is an uneven number of entries, the highest/higher divisions will feature the extra bowler(s) (A then B then C, and so on). We are anticipating at least 80 entries.

Other:

A. Bowlers may bowl the tournament two times, but they may only win one prize.

B. Knocking down 9 or 10 pins on the first ball will be scored as a strike.

C. The tournament director has final say over all matters not covered by these rules.

D. The results of this tournament will be posted at GoBowlingMinnesota.com.

E. The tournament director reserves the right to cancel the tournament if there are less than 12 entries. If the tournament is canceled, all entry fees will be refunded in full.

To Reserve A Spot In The Tournament: Send an email to josh@mhsb.org with the following information: A. Bowler's name; Desired Shift Time; Bowler's Email Address; Bowler's Phone Number; the average the bowler will be using for the tournament; and up to 3 friend requests (i.e. who you would like to bowl on the same lane with for the tournament).
