Loaves and Fishes is a Minnesota-based nonprofit organization whose mission is to serve free, nutritious meals to people in need at locations where the need is greatest. We are guided by our vision that all people, regardless of socioeconomic, cultural or ethnic background, deserve to meet their basic needs for food, dignity and respect.



The Farm for All Project is a farm-to-table approach to serving people in need. In 2018, we harvested over 7,000 pounds of produce, up from 4,500 pounds in 2017. Farm produce was served on over 60,000 plates in 2018!
