## Costa Rica Adventure Itinerary

### Day 1: Depart USA - Arrive San Jose, Costa Rica

Arrive in San Jose, meet your **Professional Naturalist Tour Director** and transfer to your hotel. On the 4th voyage of Christopher Columbus in 1502, the explorer and his crew discovered the Caribbean side of a beautiful territory he called, "Costa Rica" or "Rich Coast". **Costa Rica** is Central America's greatest hidden gem, a haven for eco-tourism featuring lush forests, magnificent waterfalls, rumbling volcanoes and diverse ecosystems.

### Day 2: San Jose - Poas Volcano National Park

Today enjoy the scenery of the Central Valley, surrounded by soaring mountains, strawberry plantations and flower farms. Visit a **Coffee Plantation** to sample fresh Costa Rican coffee and learn about the history and cultivation of the coffee bean. Later travel past tropical landscapes for a visit of **Poas Volcano National Park** to view the dramatic mile wide crater from an overlook. Also stop at the **Sarchi Artisan Village**, known as the cradle of craftsmanship and an ideal place to shop for an oxcart, Costa Rica's best known craft & souvenir. Overnight in the Arenal Volcano National Park area (La Fortuna) for the next two evenings. Tonight join your traveling companions for a **Welcome Dinner**.

### Day 3: La Fortuna - Day of Leisure

Today enjoy the amenities of your resort and spa hotel. The resort features a wonderful viewing angle of the Arenal Volcano and is surrounded by lush gardens, walking paths, excellent bird watching, swimming pools and hot springs. Enjoy dinner at the resort.

### Day 4: Arenal Volcano Nat'l Park - Monteverde

This morning visit the **Arenal Volcano National Park**, one of the 10 most active volcanoes in the world. Its constant emissions of gases and lava will amaze you. Later check into your hotel in the **Monteverde Cloud Forest** area for a two night stay and enjoy dinner.

### Day 5: Monteverde

Today experience the conservation project at **Selvatura Park**. Enjoy a unique opportunity to walk across **Hanging Bridges** & discover first hand the natural beauty of the **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve**, one of the largest and most enchanting wildlife sanctuaries in the Americas. Enjoy

interesting visits to the **Butterfly Garden**, home to 50 different species, and the **Hummingbird Gallery**, home to many species from the cloud forest.

*Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Monteverde*

### Day 6: Monteverde - Jaco Beach/Puntarenas

This morning travel west via motorcoach to the Jaco Beach/Puntarenas Beach area, located on the Pacific Coast of Costa Rica for a two night resort stay. Jaco Beach/Puntarenas area is one of the most visited coastal destinations in Costa Rica and is well known for wildlife viewing, sport fishing and surfing. Enjoy a visit to the **Carara National Park**, a tropical bird and wildlife sanctuary and one of the world's few nesting places for the scarlet macaw.

*Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Jaco Beach/Puntarenas*

### Day 7: Morning at Leisure - Crocodile Cruise

Enjoy the morning at leisure to relax and enjoy the amenities of the resort complex. Maybe take an optional excursion via Tranopy or Zip Line. Later set out for an exciting **Jungle Crocodile Safari Cruise**. The 2-hour cruise highlights crocodiles and spectacular bird-viewing while cruising the Tarcoles River.

### Day 8: Jaco Beach/Puntarenas - San Jose

This morning enjoy a bit of leisure time before departing for San Jose. Enroute visit an **Orchid Garden** and gain insight into the stunning diversity of orchids. Tonight enjoy a special **Farewell Dinner**.

#### Part A - Cancellation Waiver provided by PWD

**I. Trip Cancellation Waiver (TCW)** - Guarantees full refund on all payments, except the TPP Fee itself in case of cancellation up to the time and date of departure due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family; or, if the passenger must return early due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family, a refund for the unused land services. Medical/official documentation required.

**II. Premier "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver (ARCW)** - Reimburses 75% of the cancellation fees in the form of a future travel credit certificate (FTCC) valid for 1 year, if you cancel more than 48 hours prior to scheduled departure for any reason not eligible for cash refund under the TCW (Part A - I). FTCC is non-transferable, may not be redeemed for cash and does not include any credit for the TPP Fee. The TPP Fee (if chosen) is refundable until 180 days prior to departure & cannot be added after Final Payment. The TPP does not cover any single supplement charges due to an indi-
