



Minnesota Housing Fix Up Loan Program

The Center for Energy and Environment (CEE) and Minnesota Housing offer low interest loans for Minnesota homeowners to make improvements in their homes. CEE, a Minneapolis based nonprofit organization, is the lender for this program and will assist homeowners through the loan process.

Program Features

- Call for current interest rates
- Loan amounts from \$2,000–\$75,000
- Terms up to 20 years
- Maximum income:
 - 11-county Twin Cities Metro Area, Dodge County, and Olmsted County: \$185,700
 - All other counties: \$167,000
- 1–4 unit, owner-occupied primary residence
- Individually owned townhomes and condominiums eligible
- Terms & conditions apply. Contact CEE.

Eligible Improvements:

Eligible projects include most interior and exterior permanent improvements including solar panels, kitchen, flooring, windows, driveways, fences, energy improvements, accessibility improvements and more!

1 bid is required from a licensed, qualified contractor.

For do-it-yourself projects, a materials list including prices is required. The cost for labor and equipment purchase or rental may not be included in the loan.
