# **Washer and Dryer Preventative Maintenance (PM)**

**Dryer preventative maintenance** 

It is very important to maintain your dryers on a weekly, monthly, and quarterly basis. Keep your dryers as lint free as possible, that means

cleaning the burner section and the lint compartment. The lint screen should be cleaned every 4 hours. When cleaning, check the lint screen for holes. If there are holes it should be replaced. The burner section at the top and belt section at the rear should be cleaned with a vacuum a least monthly. Have a regular PM schedule to reduce chance of dryer fires.



Washer maintenance should be done on a quarterly, semi-annual, and yearly basis. This is determined by how often you run your machines. Check the belts for wear, change the oil if the machine calls for it, check the water valves for leaks and make sure the drain valve is holding water and not leaking during the cycle – observe by looking into the drain trough.

### **Parts Ideas From Barb**

#### **Parts Warranty**

Some customers have preconceived notions about warranty. They either think that they do not have any warranty, or they think they get a lifetime warranty. I will set the record straight.

Everyone who purchases new equipment should have a warranty policy on their service agreement. If you cannot find this, I can usually look it up in our system.

Warranty policies differ by vendor-some have three years; some have 90 days. All parts purchased have a warranty policy.

I can submit a warranty claim on your behalf for parts that are in the warranty time frame. Even certain parts that are considered wear & tear are sometimes approved.

Different manufacturers have specific regulations to their brand. This includes the length of time of the warranty parts and what parts are covered.

When you place an order for a part that you believe is under warranty, please let me know at the time of the order. I will ask you questions like "What is the model and serial number of the machine?" and "What may have caused the failure of the part?" If you do not know the answers, I may be able to help.

As a general rule, do not throw away any parts that may be considered warranty unless instructed to do so by me.



Remember warranty parts only cover the cost of the part. The manufacturers never pay for the shipping expense.
