Industrial Washer-Extractors and Drying Cabinets for Optimal Cleaning of Firefighter Turnout Gear

Milnor's industrial-grade made-in-USA Gear Guardian washer-extractors are created specifically for firefighter turnout gear, to clean and to decontaminate it properly.

User-friendly microprocessor controls prompt you through each programming step and prevent errors. And, all Gear Guardian washer-extractors comply with NFPA 1851 standards in maintenance and care of protective gear.

Gear Guardian washer-extractors have multiple control options, all with programmable wash formulas, including those developed strictly for decontaminating firefighter gear (all 10 can be re-programmed). The machine features a continuously welded frame, smaller footprint, and RinSave water saver software.

The washer's cylinder features tall rips for enhanced M.A.F. (Mechanical Action Factor) and superior open area, which promotes greater interchange of chemistry and water in the load.

The most advanced of these machines also features MilTouch™ control with GearTrace™ feature Milnor's touchscreen microprocessor is the most flexible control in the industry, providing advanced management and reporting for the fire industry. The graphic run screen gives you unprecedented control and insight into your wash. The control's USB port is there for you to move or back up formulas — saving time. The GearTrace feature can also track and report wash history for every barcoded gear item, assisting with NFPA 1851 guidelines on gear recordkeeping. These wash histories can be stored inside the MilTouch controller or the data can be exported out to other data management programs.

The GearTrace feature is easy to use: 1. The user selects a formula. 2. The control prompts the user to scan PPE barcodes. 3. A barcode scanner (included) records SKU numbers stitched into gear.

GearTrace software records these SKUs and associates them with each specific wash cycle, at that time. 4. Those SKUs are stored in memory with each specific wash and can be downloaded as .csv values via the USB port or network connection.

Cabinet dryers will properly dry your delicate gear, allowing your firefighters to safely respond to emergency calls for

2025 Inspection Checklists for your Washer and Dryer

A new year brings a fresh start

Now is a great time to check over your equipment for potential issues. Using best preventative practices can keep machines running at their best—providing optimal results and preventing costly repairs, and ensuring that you and your customers are best able to use your machines safely.

Washer check list:

- 1. Check for physical damage to machine. Does it affect its operation?
- 2. Check machine mounts (loose bolts & grout, cracked concrete)
- 3. Check door and service panels for proper fit (make necessary adjustments)
- 4. Check door bumper and gaskets for wear
- 5. Check door locks for proper operation.
- 6. Check all drive belts for wear and cracks
- 7. Check for leaks (water, oil, drain valve)
- 8. Check for any excessive noise

Dryer check list:

- 1. Check for any physical damage
- 2. Check for any excessive operational noise
- 3. Check basket trunnion and bearing tolerance
- 4. Remove front panels to vacuum all lint build up (annually)
- 5. Check doors and service panels for proper fit (make necessary adjustments)
- 6. Check for gas or steam leaks
- 7. Check lint screens for holes (replace as necessary)
- 8. Check drive train, clean, adjust and lube (if applicable)
- 9. Inspect belts for wear and adjust to proper tension
- 10. Check exhaust for any damage (should be cleaned once a year)
- 11. Clean the tumble-dryer thoroughly (annually—at least). Minnesota Chemical can assist with this on a time-and-materials basis if desired.
