## IMPORTANT LEAGUE NOTES & INFORMATION

**Player Sanctions:** Captains packets will be outfit will sanction slips. On the first night of pool, I need each player to fill out slip and insert with scoresheet. Any NEW Player to a roster MUST Fill a slip out and enter it into the envelope. **THIS GOES FOR ALL PLAYERS THE FIRST NIGHT OF LEAGUE—OR THE FIRST NIGHT THEY SUB IN A LEAGUE OUTSIDE THEIR REGULAR NIGHT.** Dues will still be taken at the end of the year, but this will help in identifying which teams players want sanction fees taken from.

**Player Rankings:** Player Rankings will be based primarily on CompuSport's Power Ranking Formula applied to every eligible player in all leagues. The Formula was applied to everyone in all leagues to find ranking "Tiers" within the MCC League Base. Players individual power rankings them identify which tier they should be placed in. Exemptions will be made and a finalized rankings list will be produced after ranking "committee" meets to evaluate power ranking results sometime this fall.

The Power Ranking Formula is:

$$((\text{Total Score}/2) + (\text{wins} *3) + (10-0 \text{ wins} *2) + (\text{ERO} *4))$$

$$\text{-----} = \text{Power Ranking}$$

**League Liaison:** The League Liaison was elected by the league members who attended the league meeting. This individual will:

**League Format/Scheduling:** Your Format is: 5 Player, 25 Game Format.

**NO SUBS MAY BE ADDED AFTER DEC 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.**

- Your League elected to allow Midwest Coin Concepts to complete a schedule THAT BESTS FITS THE LEAGUE and has you done IN NO LESS THAN 21 WEEKS.
- USE LAST YEARS AVG. FOR FIRST 15 GAMES OF SEASON. IF 15 GAMES SHALL BE EXCEEDED IN MIDDLE OF A LEAGUE NIGHT, PLAYER WILL USE PREVIOUS AVERAGE UNTIL THE 15<sup>TH</sup> GAME IS COMPLETE AND THEN CURRENT AVERAGE FOR ANY GAME THEREAFTER.
- New players enter league with a 7 AVG and will remain that average until that player has shot 15 GAMES. IF 15 GAMES ARE EXCEEDED IN MIDDLE OF MATCH, PLAYER WILL BE A 7 AVERAGE UNTIL THAT PLAYERS 16<sup>TH</sup> GAME IS STARTED—AT WHICH POINT THEY WILL USE CURRENT LEAGUE AVERAGE.
- **IF A ROSTER HAS A VACANT SPOT: THAT VACANT SPOT WILL BE FILLED WITH THE HIGHEST AVG. PLAYER FROM EITHER TEAM WHO IS SHOOTING THAT NIGHT.**
- If amount of teams is unequal, the last place team in any position round week will receive AVG 8-Ball Points & AVG Round Wins based on their season statistics.
- PLEASE NOTIFY OPPOSING TEAM IF YOUR TEAM WILL BE RUNNING LATE-COMMUNICATION IS KEY! REPEAT OFFENDERS OF BEING LATE MAY BE REPRIMANDED AS SEEN FIT BY LEAGUE.

**Playoffs:** Your league has elected to have playoffs.

- All teams will advance to playoffs.
  - Playoffs will be shot out on Monday with HIGH SEED HOSTING the match.
  - Loser Bracket matches MUST BE shot PRIOR to following Monday so to keep pace with the winner side of the bracket.
    - If a tie occurs on total 8-ball points the TIE-BREAKER SHALL BE:
      - Play Last Round Over against same opponent
      - Lower Average gets ball difference from opponent's higher average
      - If Higher average player wins round, lower player gets balls pocketed + ball average difference.
- (I.E. A 9 Avg beats a 7 Avg. 10-4. Difference = 2, losing player get's the 4 balls pocketed + difference, so actual score player lost by is 10-6.)**

**League Money:** Your league has elected to pay back to do payback's as following:  
70% 8-Ball Points, 30% goes to playoffs.
