NEW HYDE PARK

The LIRR Expansion Project from Floral Park to Hicksville, one of the region's most significant transportation infrastructure projects, is now underway throughout the communities along a nearly ten mile stretch of mainline track.

During the month of October, you will see construction crews performing work in New Hyde Park. Specifically, crews are continuing their work to relocate and install underground utilities. Additionally, crews will perform pre-demolition work at 115 New Hyde Park Road and 124 Covert Avenue. By way of explanation:

Covert Avenue Underground Utility Relocation

- Along Covert Avenue, construction teams from 3rd Track Constructors, National Grid, PSEG Long Island, Verizon, Altice, and Light Tower (or their respective contractors) will need to periodically limit traffic to a single lane to allow for the underground utilities to be relocated
- Additionally, as part of this work, traffic will be limited on Wayne Avenue, S 5th Street, 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue
- While traffic may be impacted through the end of the year, the construction team will provide cones, flagmen and signage at the work site, as needed, to minimize interruptions

Pre-Demolition Activities at 115 New Hyde Park Road and 124 Covert Avenue

- Performing environmental testing of the existing structure in anticipation of future demolition
