## What's the Difference Between a Seedling and a Transplant?

Transplants are seedlings that have spent a year or more in a transplant bed. A transplant bed provides the baby seedling more care than it would receive in a field and more room than it would have in a seedbed. The result is that a transplanted seedling will have a more fully developed root system than that of the untransplanted seedling. The first number in the age represents the years in the seedling bed and the second number represents the years in the transplant bed. Some transplants are initially grown in a greenhouse. They are known as plug transplants. Transplants grow faster and have a greater rate of survival than seedlings. ## **TERMS**

The prices on this sheet are for trees picked up at our farm at Cambridge, MN on Hwy. 95, 1/4 mile east of Hwy. 47. Shipping by Speedee or our truck at customer's request.

Terms: 25% down payment, balance on pickup or prior to shipping. All orders of seedling should be placed in quantities of 25 with a minimum of 25 plants per species. All orders of transplants should be placed in quantities of 10 per species. For example, we won't sell 15 WP 2-1, and 35 NP 2-1. All prices are subject to change without notice until order is confirmed by down payment.
